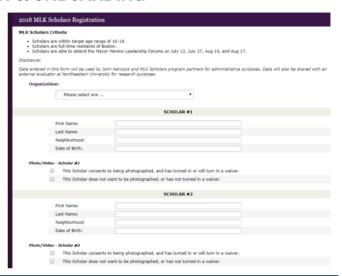

- Collect all waivers as ONE bundle, and turn in as a pdf upload via Scholar Registration.



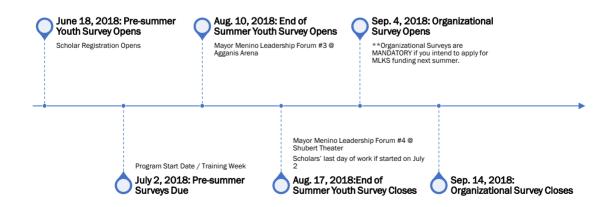
