

# Create Your Own Calendar



Keep track of your summer with a calendar you decorate yourself. Just print off the July and August pages (or get an adult to do it for you) and you're ready to go! Here are some ideas to get you started...but feel free to do anything you can dream up.

## **Idea #1: Summer sketches**

What's your favourite summertime activity? Swimming? Riding your bike? Running through the sprinkler? Draw something fun in the main square.

## **Idea #2: Make a collage**

Cut pictures out of old magazines, use your own drawings, or throw in photos (if an adult says it's okay). Layer them in interesting ways and use them to tell a story.

## **Idea #3: Make it 3D**

Glue yarn, buttons, pipe cleaners, foam stickers, flowers or whatever else you can find. (You may need to glue your calendar page to a piece of construction paper or cardboard to keep it from flopping...).

## **Idea #4: Draw your favourite dino**

Get out the crayons/pencilcrayons/markers/paint and create your own version of a T-Rex, stegosaurus or velociraptor – try it freehand or trace a photo.

## **Idea #5: Glitter it up**

Write your name or a word like “summer” or “sunshine” in white glue and throw a bunch of glitter on there. Once the glue is dry, shake off the extra glitter (into a container, not onto the floor!) and watch your word sparkle.

## **Idea #6: Be abstract**

Use watercolours or crayons to create a feeling with colours, like happiness or peace or excitement.

## **Idea #7: Use stickers to mark special days.**

Cakes or balloons can help you remember birthdays, suitcases will help you count down to trips, puppies will remind you it's your turn to walk the dog. Don't have the right stickers on hand? Don't worry! Make your own by cutting out tiny pictures and gluing or taping them to the page.
